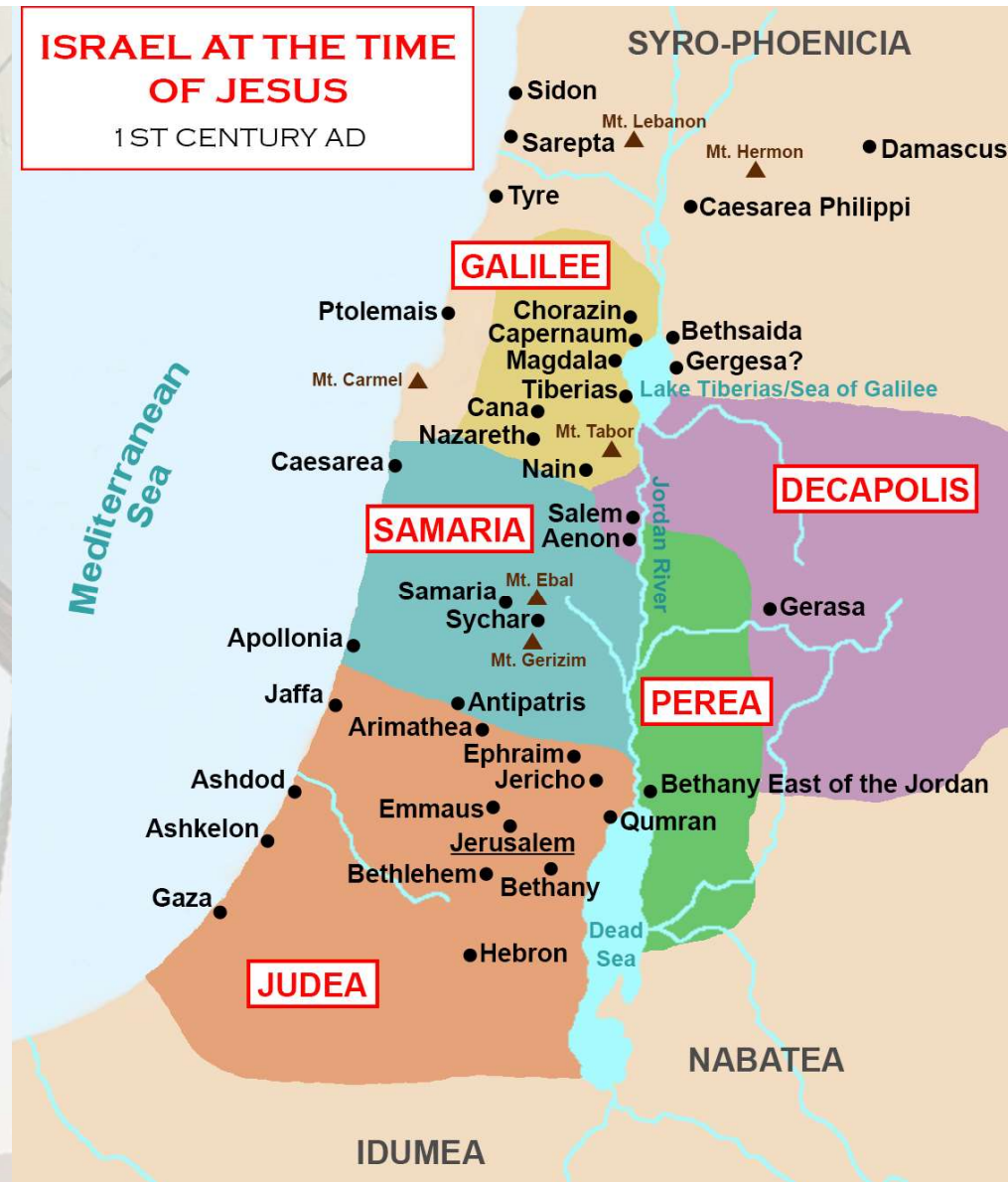




II. We need to learn from Jesus. (13-19)
