# I. Jesus invites us to have confidence in Him. (1-2)

- A. See death through the lense of the resurrection.
- B. The transfiguration was a preview of Jesus' future coming in glory. (2 Pet. 1:16-19)
- C. God wants to transform believers into the likeness of Jesus. (Rom. 12:2; 2 Cor. 3:18)

And do not be conformed to this world, but be **transformed** by the renewing of your mind, so that you may prove what the will of God is, that which is good and acceptable and perfect.

## II. Jesus leads a second Exodus. (2-8)

A. Jesus is the new Lawgiver and Prophet.

(Exod. 24:12-18)


B. As the Son of God, Jesus is God.

- A. The glorious news about Jesus can now be told.
- B. Note the similarities between John the Baptist and Elijah.
- C. Jesus fulfilled all righteousness, and then took my sin.
