**DON'T MISS THIS**

I. Submit yourself to Jesus Christ. (1-6)

A. All things and situations belong to Him.

B. He has the right and ability to rule over all.

C. Listen to Him.

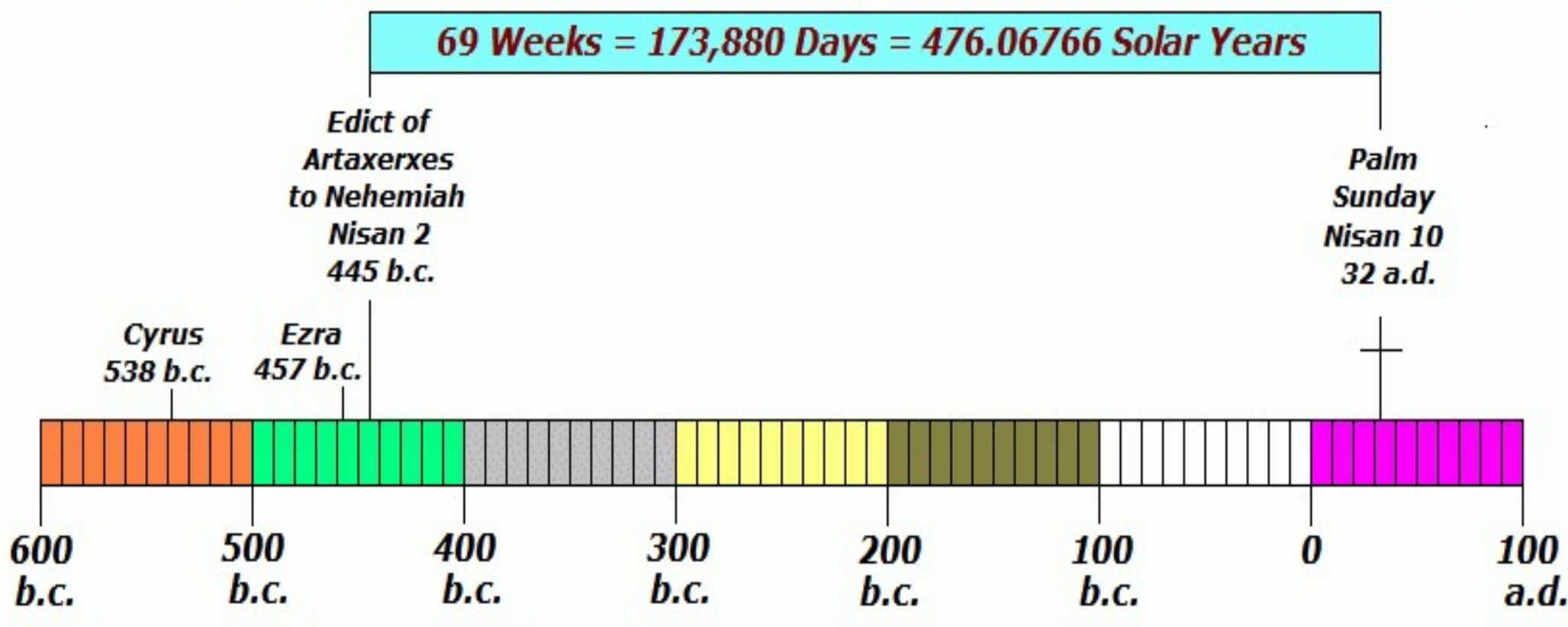
## II. Persevere under your cross, like Christ. (7-11)

A. This was the declaration of a victorious king!

B. They wanted Jesus to fix their situations.

C. Jesus understood this was his entry into my death.

***The Edict of Artaxerxes Longinus given to Nehemiah in 445 b.c. is the only edict that takes the 69 weeks or 'sevens' of Biblical (360 day) years, (173,880 days) to find 'Messiah the Prince'. The 69 weeks terminate precisely on Palm Sunday, 32 A.D.***



### III. Expect the fruit of faith in Christ. (12-14, 20-22)


A. Jesus expects fruit from His people.

C. Faith is perspective, reaching, holding on, rooted and fruitful.
