Girded with truth

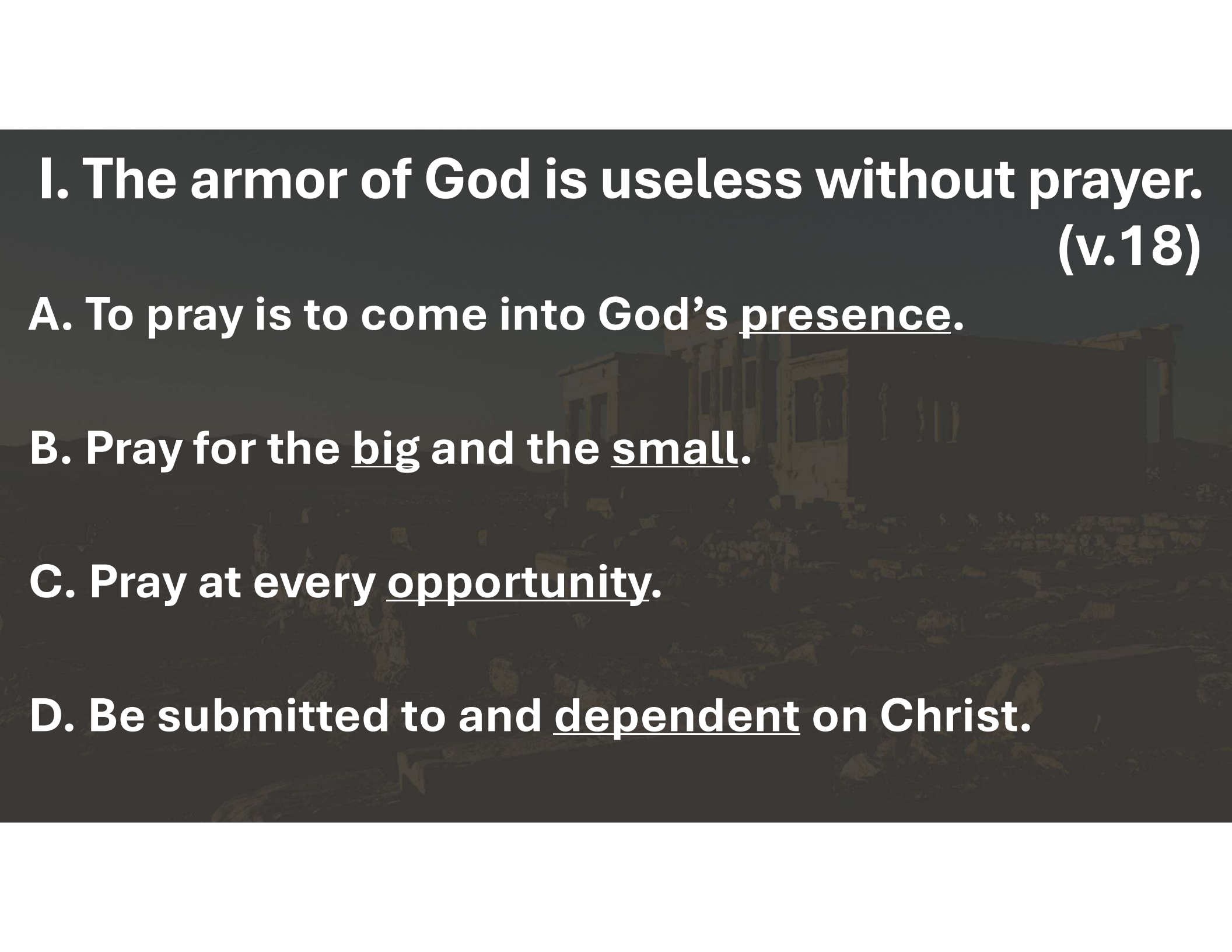
Wearing the breastplate of righteousness

Receiving the sword(Word) of the Spirit



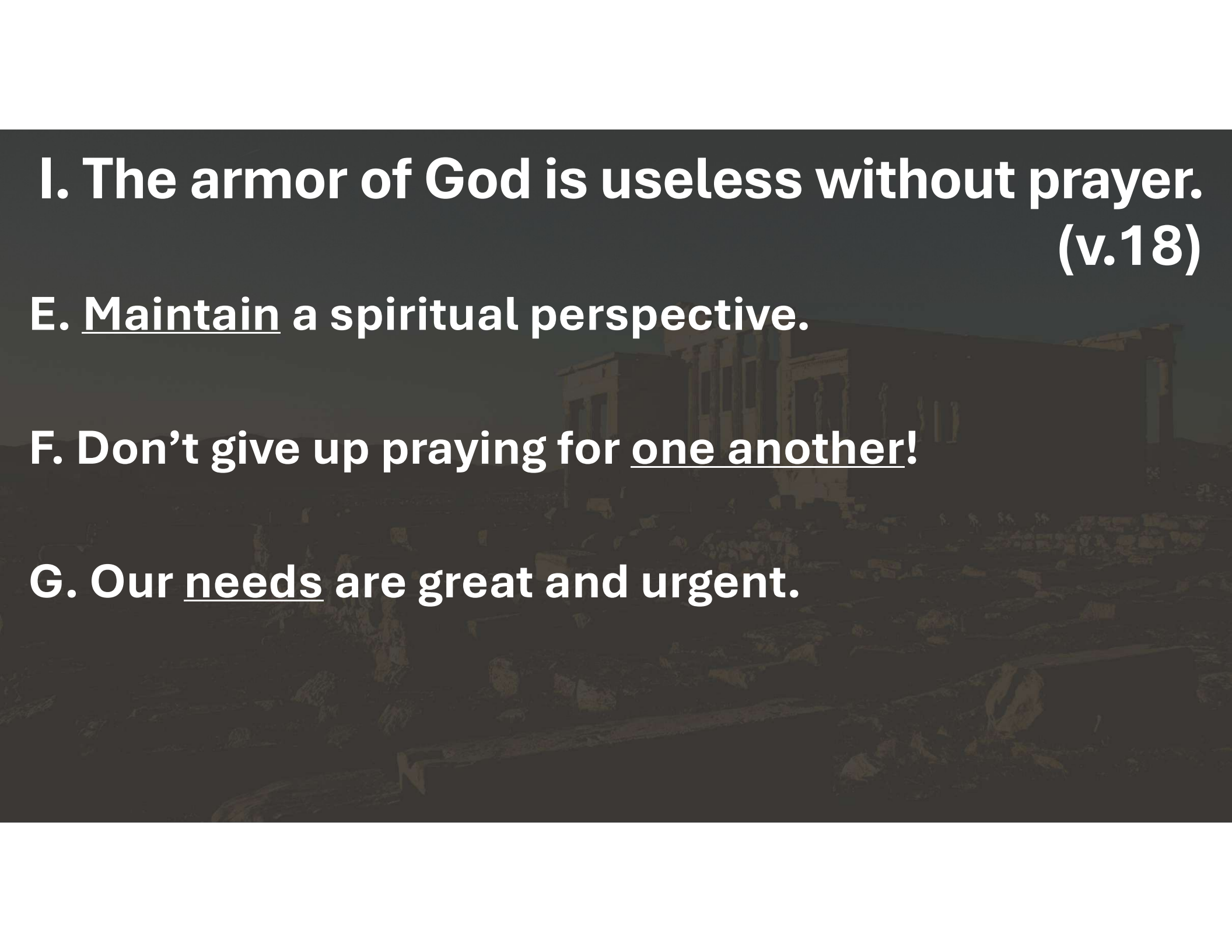

D. Be submitted to and dependent on Christ.

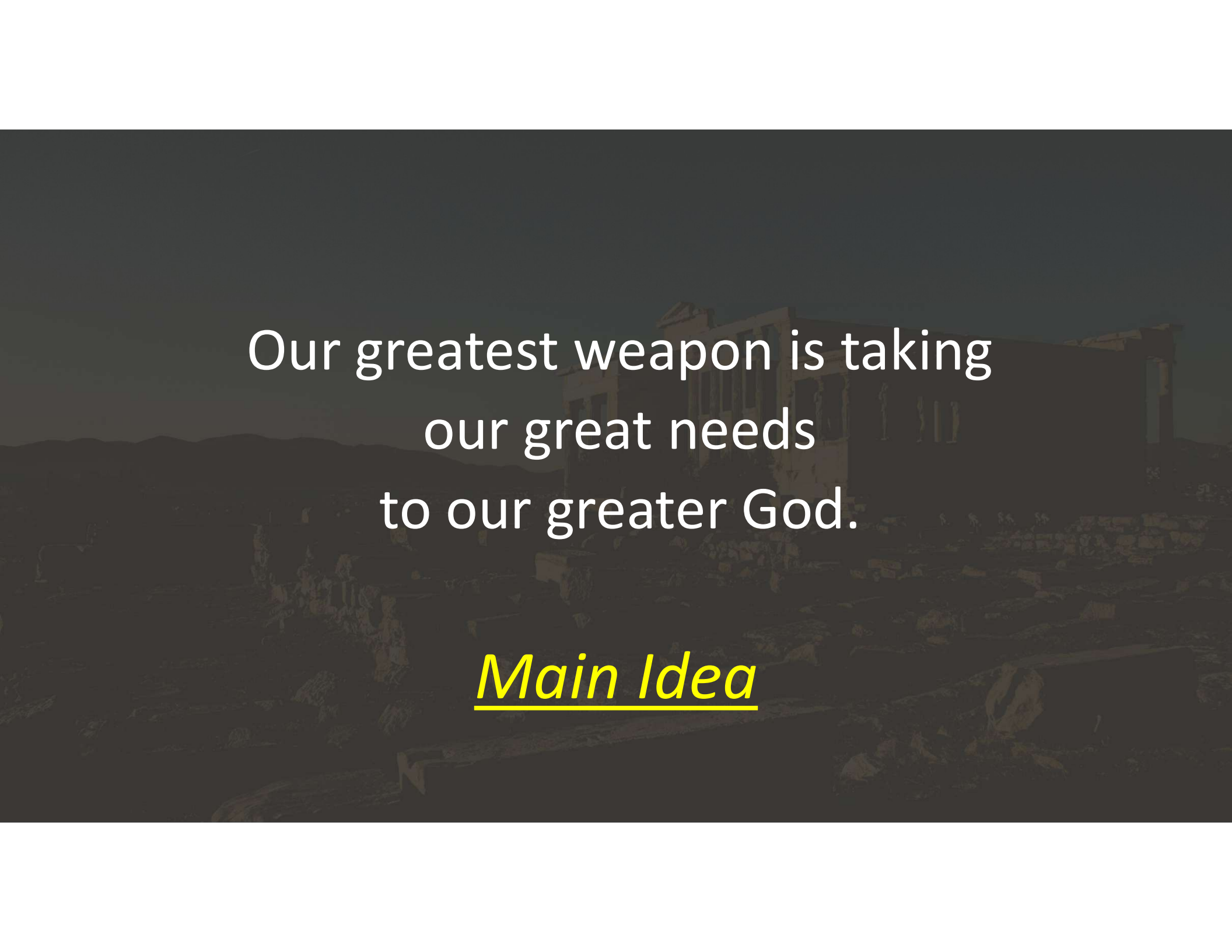
