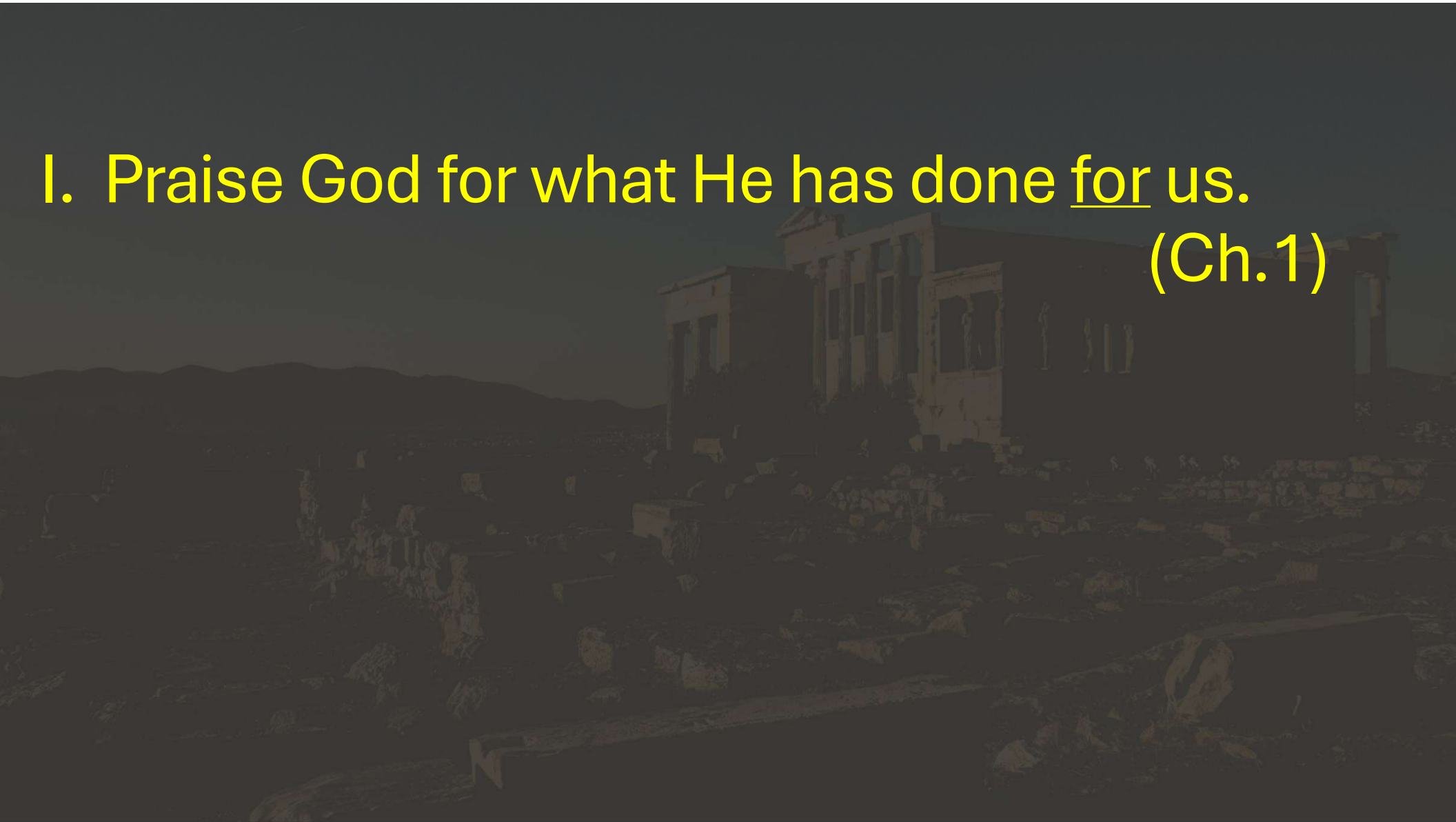




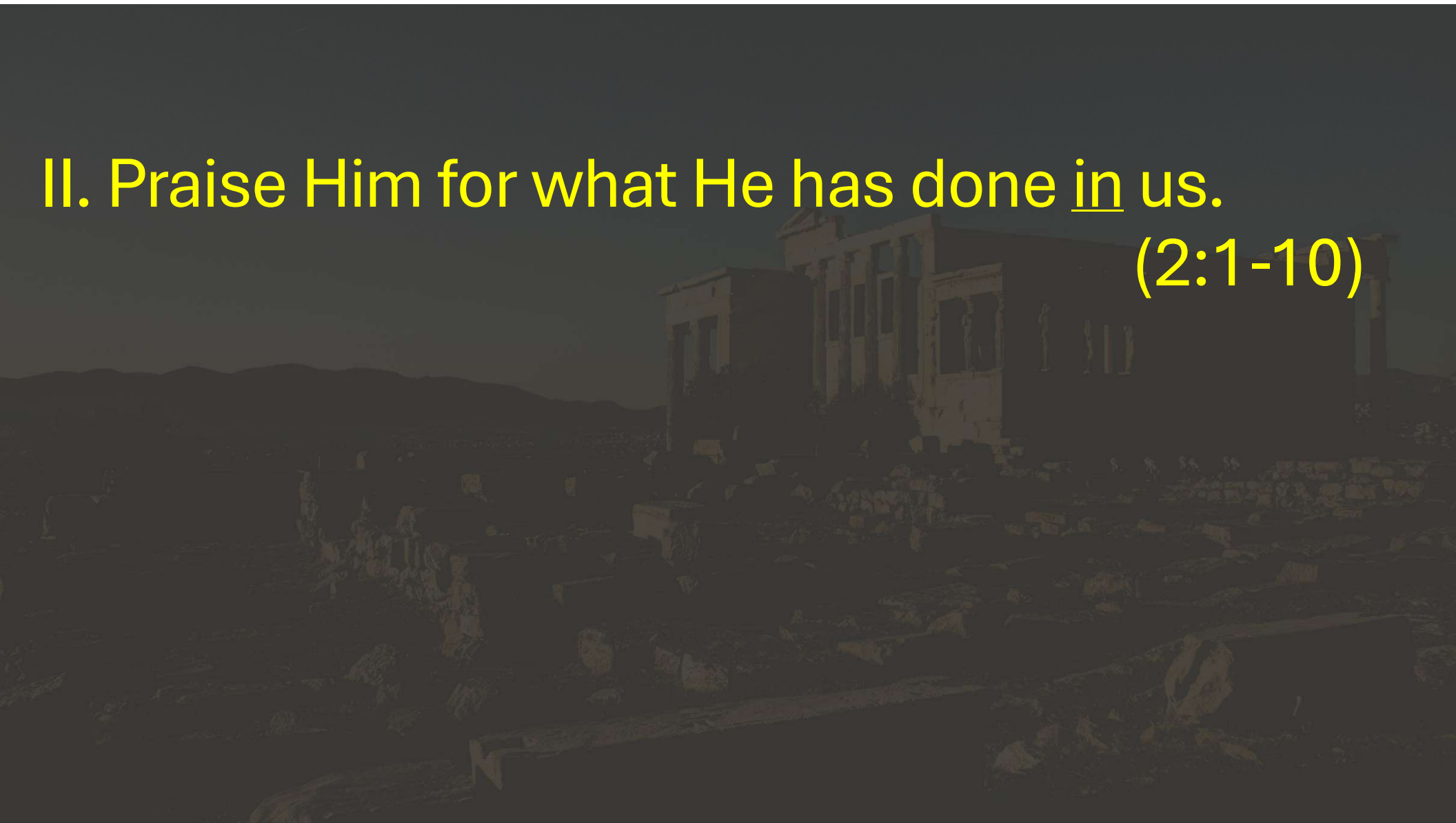




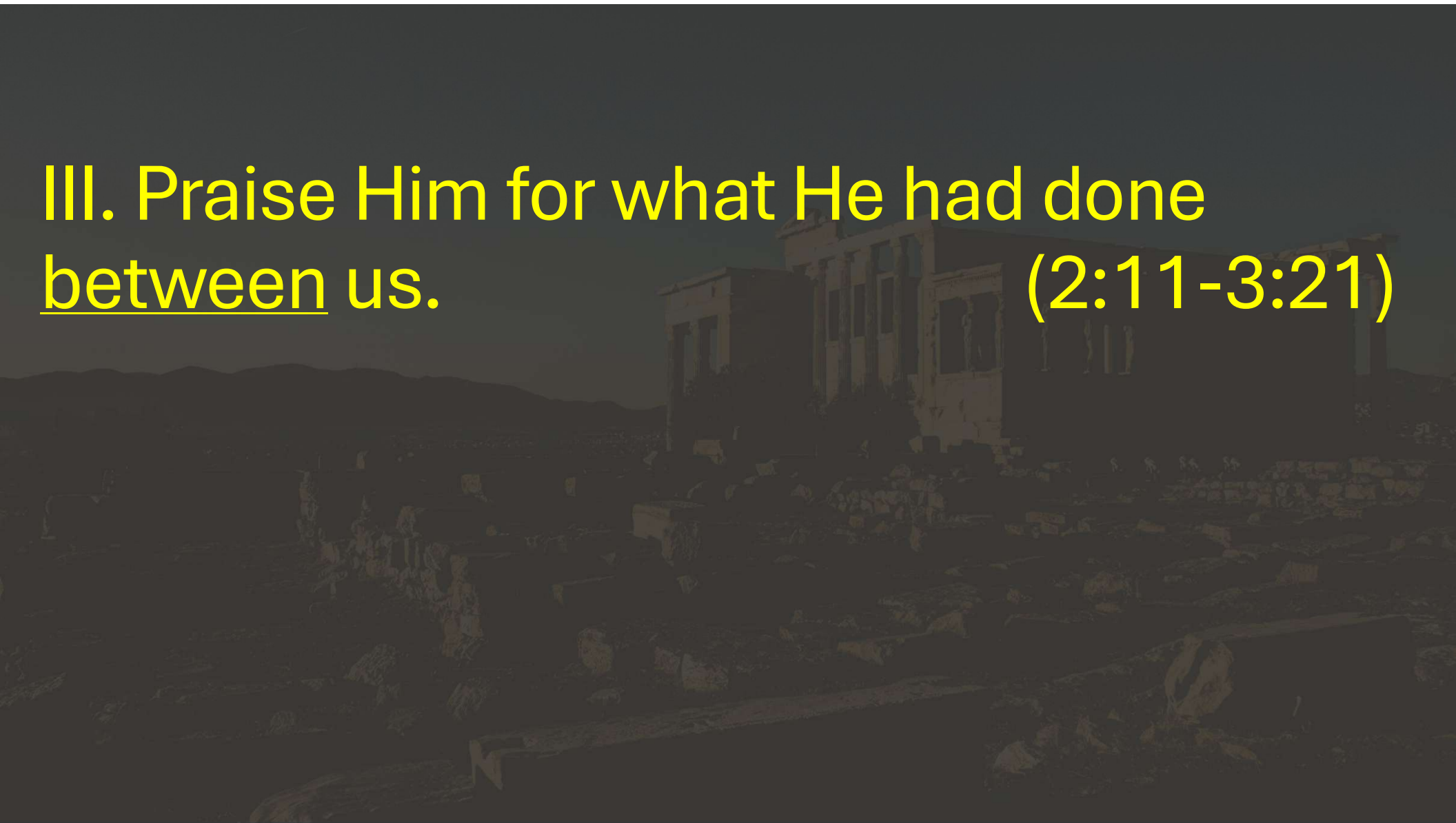
I. Praise God for what He has done for us.

(2:1-10)

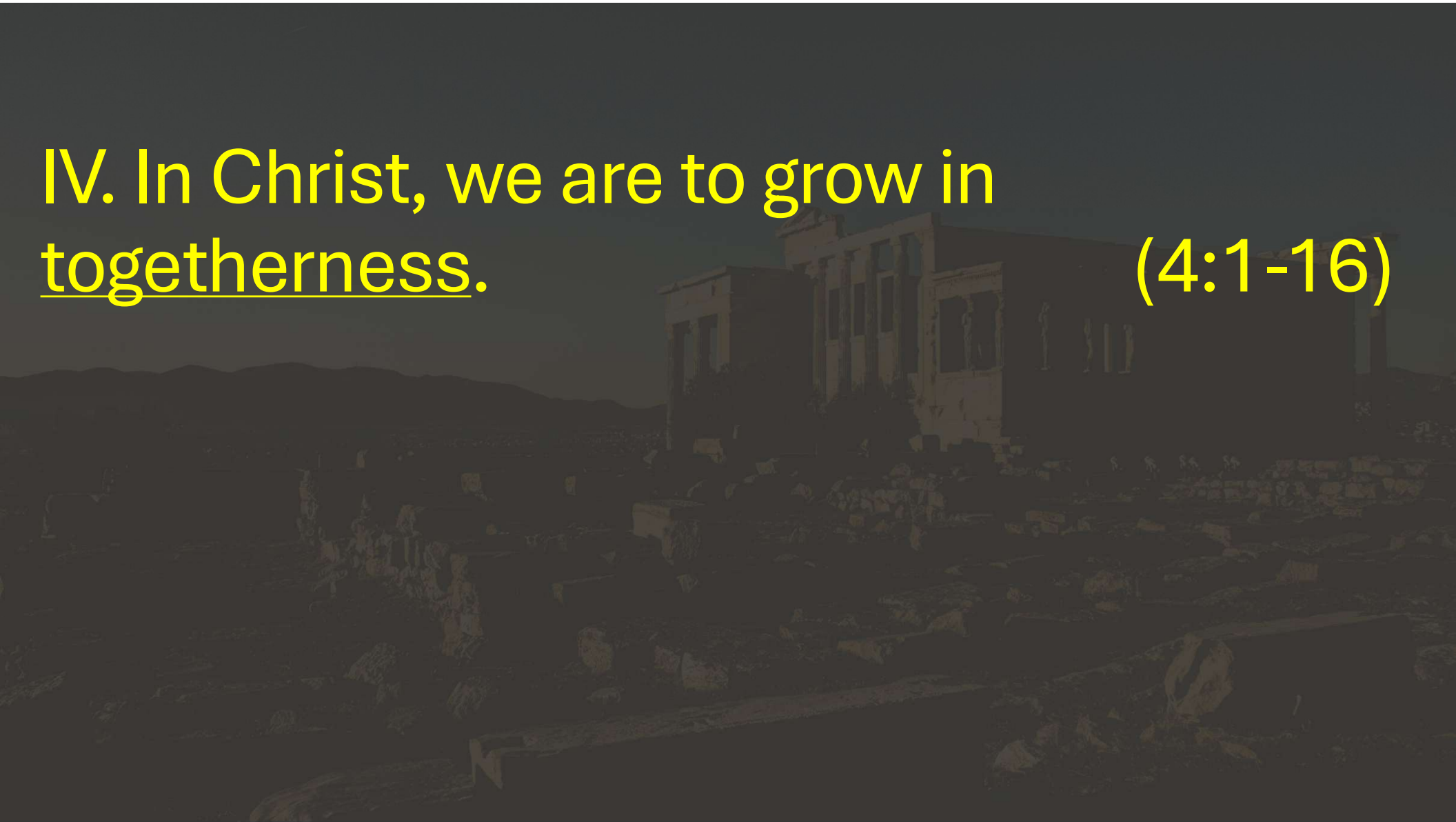


III. Praise Him for what He had done

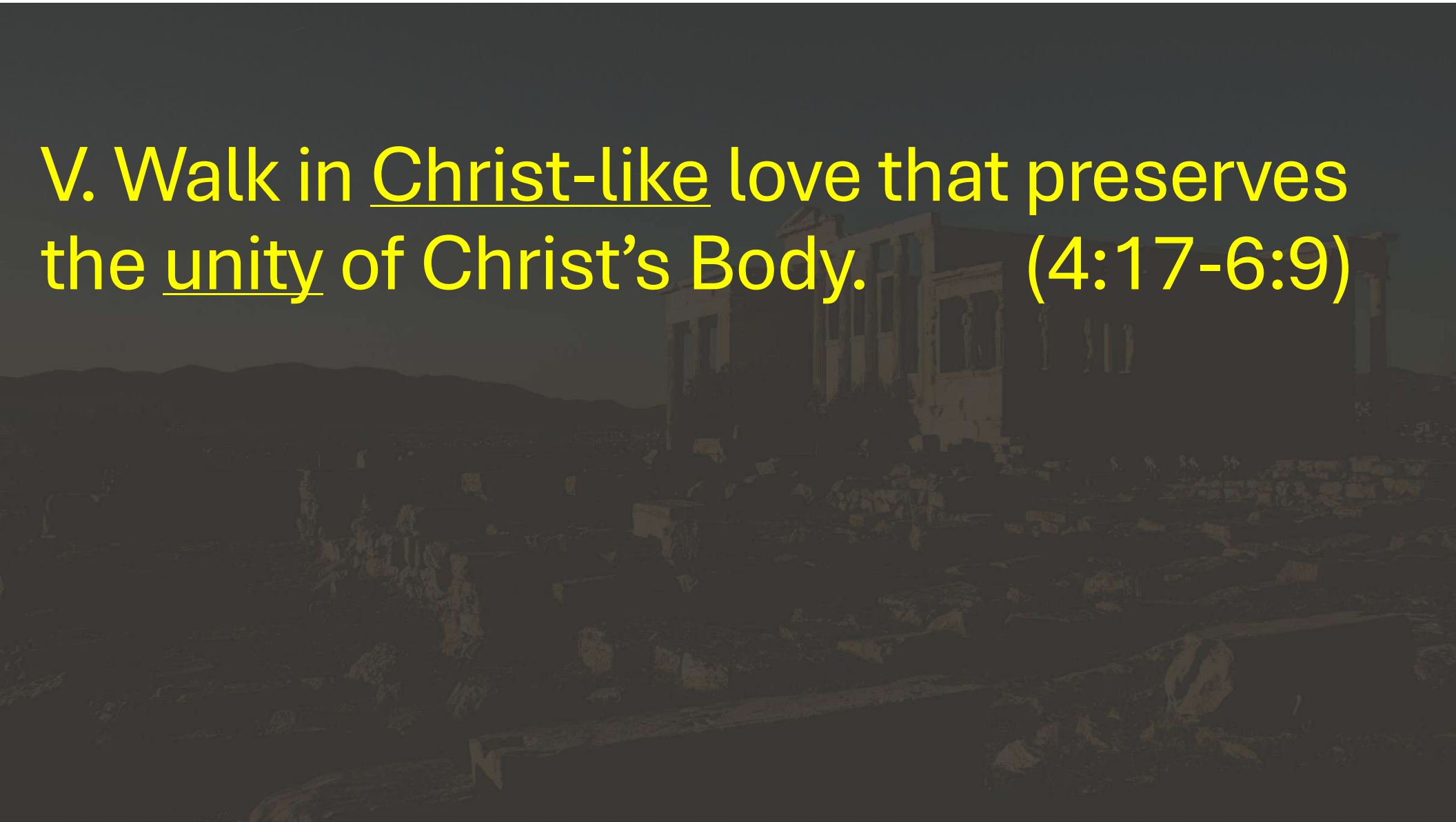

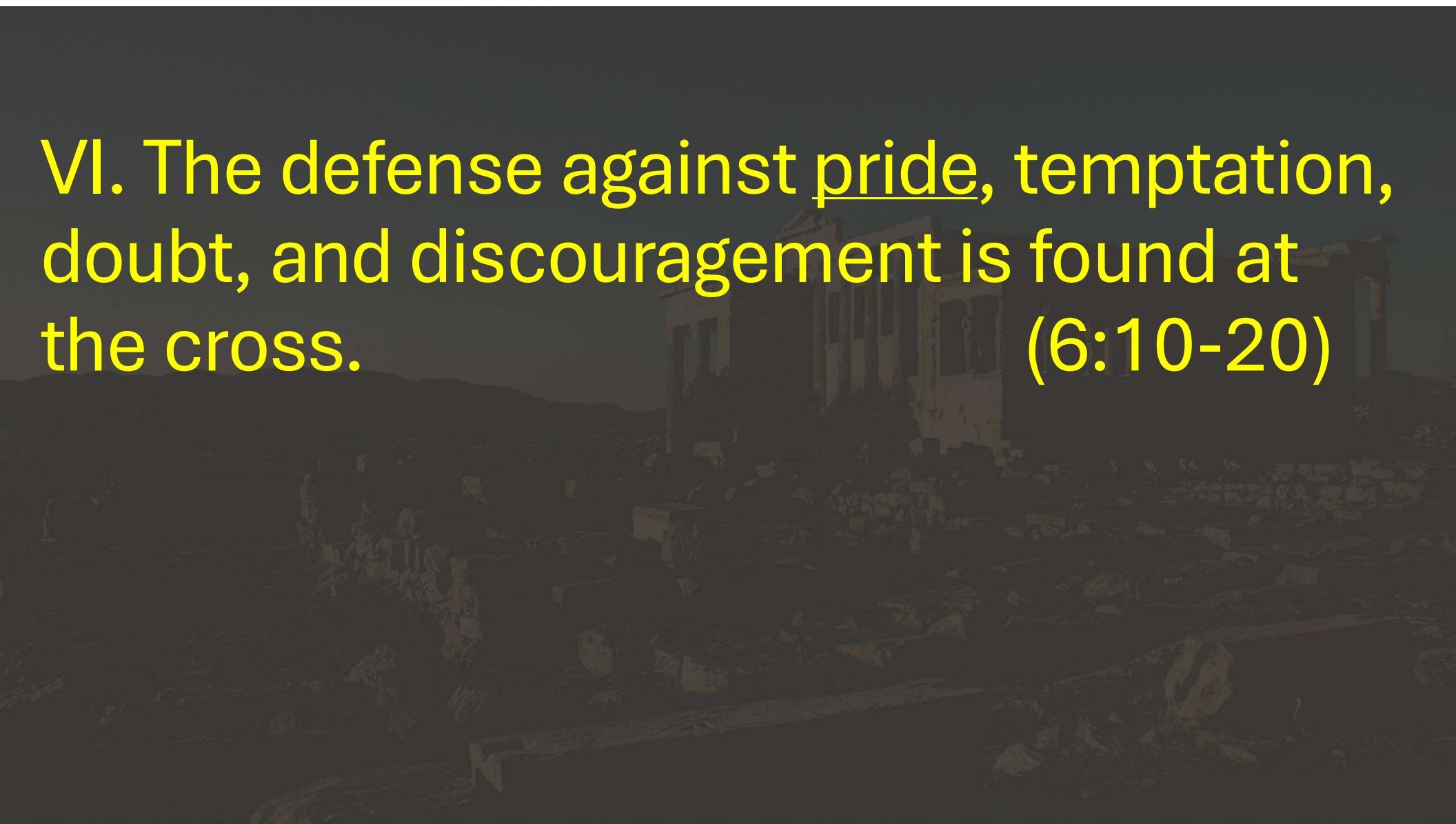

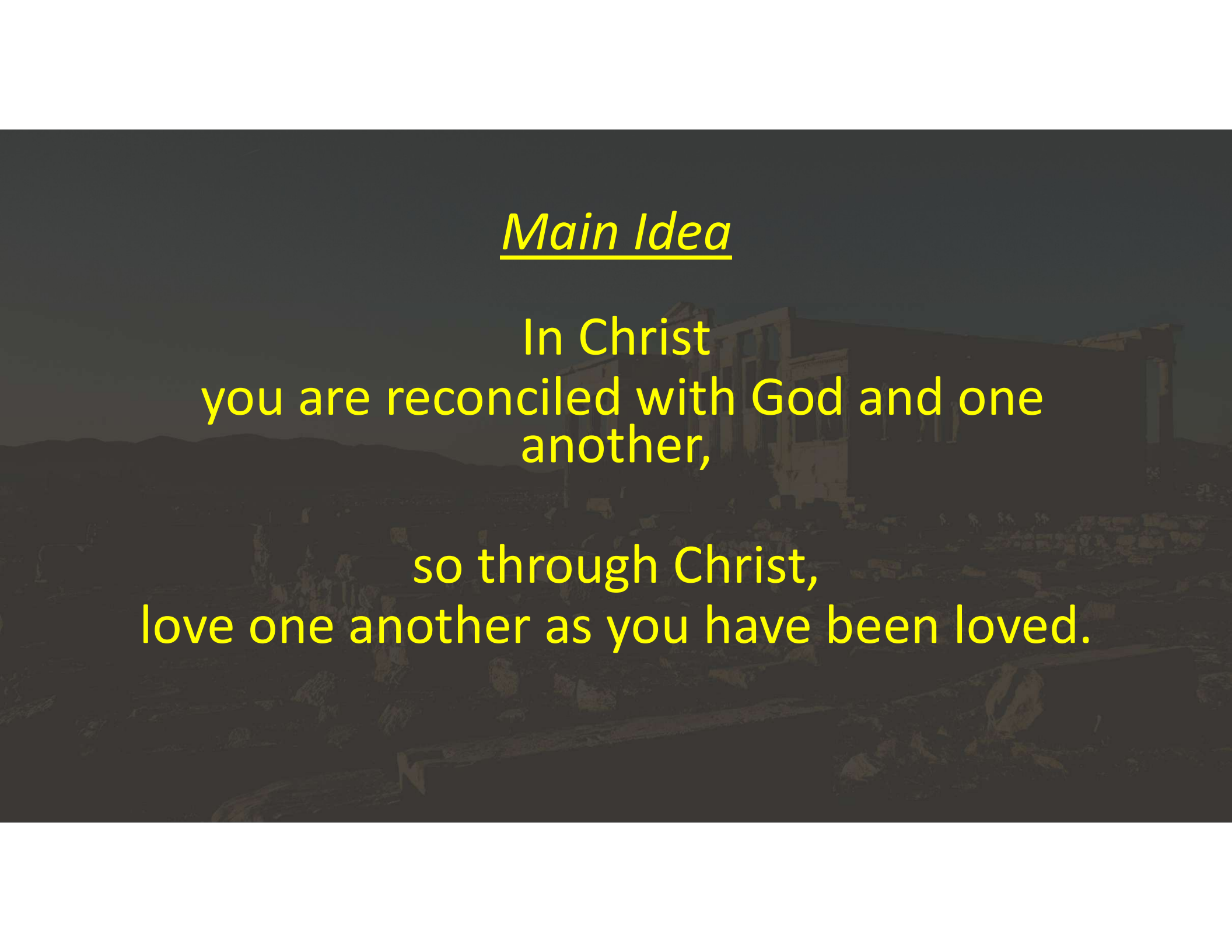


V. Walk in Christ-like love that preserves
